Instructions for Diluting

To make Adrenalin Chloride Solution	Adrenalin Chloride Solution 1:1000	Isotonic Salt Solution
1: 2000	1 fl dr	1 fl dr
1: 5000	1 fl dr	4 fl dr
1:10000	1 fl dr	9 fl dr

Note—Do not use the solution if it is pinkish or darker than slightly yellow or if it contains a precipitate.

Caution—Administer with caution to elderly people. Do not use if high blood pressure, heart disease, diabetes, or thyroid disease is present unless directed by a physician. If prompt relief is not obtained, consult a physician. Administer to pediatric patients under six years of age only on the advice of a physician.

This product is sterile until opened.

Keep this and all drugs out of the reach of children.

Store between 20° to 25°C (68° to 77°F). (See USP Controlled Room Temperature.)

Protect from light and freezing.

***Do not use if cap seal is broken or missing.**

Each mL contains 1 mg Adrenalin (EPINEPHrine) as the hydrochloride, dissolved in isotonic sodium chloride solution with 0.5% chlorobutanol (chloroform derivative) as a preservative and not more than 0.15% sodium bisulfite as an antioxidant.

Adrenalin Chloride Solution (EPINEPHrine nasal solution, USP) must not be brought into contact with oxidizing agents. The solution is also quickly decomposed by iron salts and alkalies.
